

Adaptations for wheelchair

On the basis of the official rules of refereeing and competitions (book n°10). Any non-compliance must be sanctioned.

Only the following adaptations are accepted :

- **the arms**: are accepted at the level of the vertebral axis (the transfer of body weight is limited by the sitting position)
- **lunges** replaced by a flexion of the bust
- **oblique trajectories** are accepted for vertical shots (because of the wheels)

Technical characteristics of the chair cane:

- when the fencer is facing his opponent, the touch distances are not the same for the head or the low zone: the low zone is closer than the head.
- the dodge-riposte is rarely used because it is not very tactically effective.
- the involuntary advance of the fencer in a wheelchair cane is frequent because of the kinetics of the wheelchair. Not to be confused with a voluntary anti-game attitude.
